POLICY:

The Osgoode Care Centre will have a current outbreak and emergency response plan for a declared pandemic. It is noted that in the event of a pandemic, information and requirements may change rapidly as the situation evolves. Provincial mandates will supersede local practice as the highest authority where applicable unless otherwise directed.

PROCEDURE:

The CEO will:

1. Ensure that the home is represented on any local community committee that is developing pandemic guidelines;
2. Involve all members of the Leadership Team in development of the Home's plan;
3. Ensure that the pandemic plan for the home reflects specific guidelines from the local Public Health Unit, Ontario Ministry of Health and Public Health Agency of Canada
